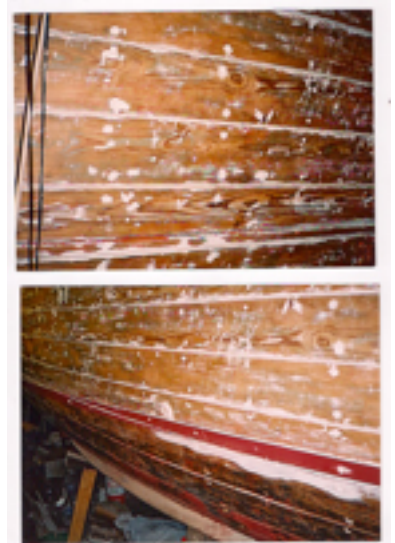

Construction

Bonheur is carvel pitch-pine copper fastened to grown oak frames and stem bent oak timbers. Decks are sheathed

pitch-pine, the coachroof, cockpit and brightwork of mahogany. She has a spoon bow, canoe stern, round bilges, long ballast keel and bilge runners.
