1937 Hillyard - 9 ton, aft cockpit, long keel, bermudian cutter.

LOA 38ft, LOD 30ft, beam 9ft, draught 4ft 9in.

Pitch pine on oak. Columbian pine tongue-and-groove deck and coachroof, overlaid with ply and Deckaplex and painted.



Tan sails. Rotostay on staysail and jib, plus spare hank-on jib.

SL manual anchor windlass. Three anchors and 40m 3/8th inch chain, plus kedge warp and chain.

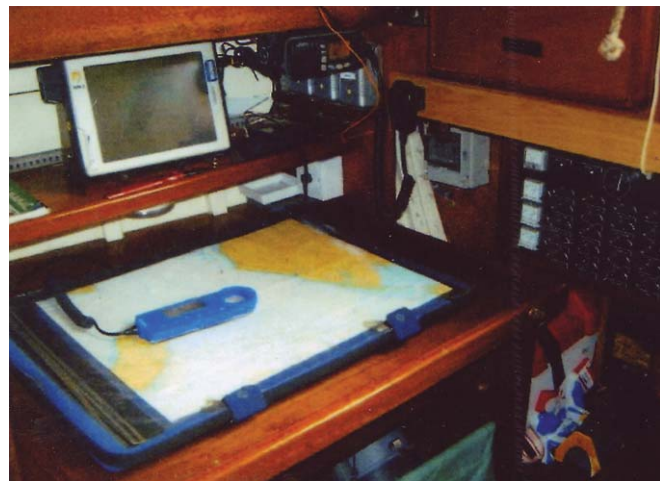
Yanmar 3 cylinder 30hp diesel. 24 gallons fuel in twin s/s tanks.

Full electrics with shore power and Merlin 30 amp generator.

Four berth layout with separate heads. Full navigation area. Taylor's heater, Origo alcohol stove and 'fridge.

She has been restored in past 25 years by Hillyards and David Moss, with new garboard planking where required. Rebuilt cockpit and new sternpost and samson post, capping and rubbing rails, deck fittings etc.
