HILLYARDS

The following list uses the Lloyds Register of Yachts (LRY) 1922 to 1980 (last year of print) as the primary source of data, supported by secondary data from the Hillyard Owners Association, the Harrison Butler Association and additional research. The list is a **guide only** as David Hillyard did not keep a written record of the boats built until after World War II and records are scarce. The LRY also relied on the information sent to them from Surveyors, the Registrar General of Shipping, Yacht Owners, Builders, Designers, and from various other sources. Names were also retained on the Register for some 'considerable' time after last update before being removed. Some boats are on a 'Registered List' however these lists are not always kept up to date and caution should be exercised. 'Original Name' is believed to be the name at time of launch. Where possible, references are shown. Note: 'Active' indicates reported activity, either under sail, berthed or stored on land.
